REFERENCE: Municipal Fleet Anti-Idling Policy

POLICY STATEMENT:

- 1. Municipal fleet vehicles will not idle unnecessarily at any time.
- 2. This policy applies to all employees who are authorized to operate vehicles and motorized equipment that is owned, leased or rented by the City of Spruce Grove.
- 3. Due to the varying nature of services provided by the City, some exemptions do apply as to not hinder the deliverance of municipal services. Exemptions to this policy include:
 - a) Assisting on an emergency scene
 - b) Extreme weather conditions (as defined by Provincial Occupational Health and Safety guidelines) where warm up areas other than an appropriately heated vehicle(s) are not available at a remote project or construction site or any other circumstances where health and safety of the employee may be jeopardized
 - c) Where the unit is not expected to restart due to mechanical problems
 - d) When the engine is required to power auxiliary equipment
 - e) Vehicle/equipment maintenance and diagnostic purposes

Note:

This policy reflects an assumption that the average vehicle requires only a few minutes to warm up in colder temperatures. Warming up a vehicle out of mechanical necessity is not considered "unnecessary." Staff are asked to exercise judgment when such cases arise.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY IS TO: Stop unnecessary engine idling of fleet vehicles and equipment to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and promote responsible fuel use.
