

## Dutch Elm Disease

Learn how to recognize Dutch Elm Disease and how to prevent it! Symptoms include: leaves suddenly wilting, leaves turning colour and shriveling but not falling, and discolouration once the bark is peeled back. Elm pruning in Alberta is permitted between October 1 – March 31.
