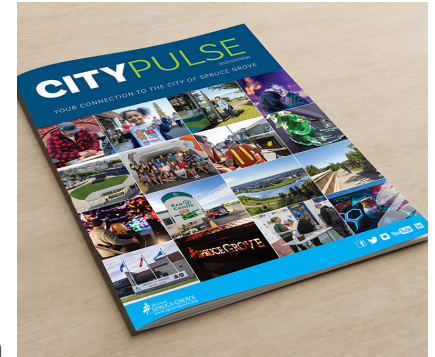
Holiday closures and impacts
