

Learn about waste collection requirements and new cart storage guidelines

When putting your black waste cart and green organics cart out for collection, please remember to keep these guidelines in mind to help ensure efficient pickup:

- Carts must be set out for collection by 7 a.m. on your collection day, but no earlier than 24 hours in advance of your collection day.
- Remember to space your waste. Ensure there is at least one meter's length of clearance on all sides of the carts.
- New! When it's not collection day, all your carts must be stored on your personal property. That means no carts on the road, sidewalk, or allev.
