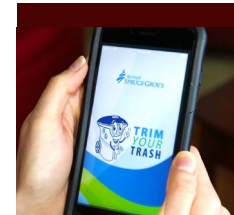

## Black Knot

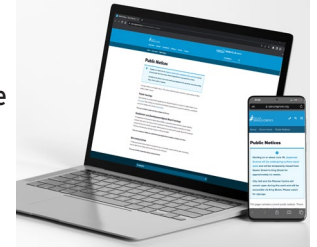
