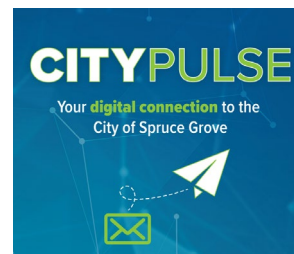

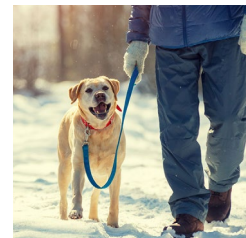

### Pick up after your pet

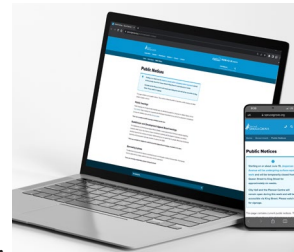
