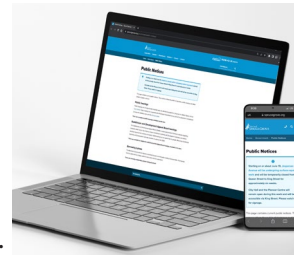
Need help filing your taxes?
