### Extra organics collection event happening April 29 – May 3

Are you planning to do some spring cleaning to your yard this month? If so, you may end up with more yard waste than what fits inside your green organics cart.

To provide residents the opportunity to easily dispose of organic materials, the City holds four extra organics collection events to help residents dispose of extra organics waste, and the first pick up event of the year is happening from April 29 – May 3. During this week, and on your regular waste collection day, residents can put extra yard/organics waste outside next to waste carts for pick up. Extra organics should be bagged in a brown paper lawn or yard waste bag.

The next extra organics collection events will occur on May 27 – 31, September 30 – October 4, and November 4 – 8.

Please note that during the rest of the year, only organics waste that fits inside the green organics cart with the lid completely closed will be collected. Bagged or other organic materials placed outside the cart will not be collected. When extra organics need to be disposed of, residents can save organics for the following collection week, practice grass-cycling to reduce yard waste, or bring extra organics to the Eco Centre at no charge (up to three cubic metres).
