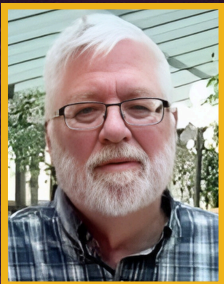

Construction Waste and Building Site Cleanliness

To help keep both the community and building sites clean, the City of Spruce Grove has incorporated construction waste and building material storage practices into our updated Community Standards Bylaw.



The Bylaw goes into effect July 1 and will help increase site safety and cleanliness by keeping building sites free from debris. To help achieve this, construction materials and equipment will now need to be stored neatly, and a dedicated waste container is required on each site.

Community Standards Bylaw

A new Community Standards Bylaw (CSB) is coming to Spruce Grove this summer! The CSB, which was passed by City Council during a May 27 meeting, will be an important tool for ensuring a safe, healthy and inviting community. The CSB and related amendments to other bylaws address topics related to public behaviour, property maintenance, neighbour relations, noise control and excessive odours. The bylaw will go into effect on July 1.

Important information for cat owners

As pet owners, we have a responsibility to care for our pets, while also being considerate of our neighbours and the community.

To bring clarity to the regulations around pet ownership in Spruce Grove and ensure the safety and well-being of residents, pets, and pet owners, the City's Dog and Domestic Animal Control Bylaw has been reviewed and updated. It is now called the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw.



Under the updated bylaw, cat owners are required to regulate the behaviour of their pets in a manner consistent with that of dogs, including:

- They are not permitted to run at large.
- They must wear a collar with ID tag containing the owner's phone number.
- They must not cause a public nuisance.
