Safe Roads. Safe Neighbourhoods.

Improving traffic safety and creating safe, sustainable neighbourhoods for all residents is important. Starting August 31, speed limits on residential neighbourhood roads will be changing from 50 km/h to 40 km/h to improve traffic safety. City Council made this decision based on recommendations from the Spruce Grove Roadway Speed Limit study conducted in 2023 that indicated reducing speed limits would not only improve traffic, but also support calmer, quieter neighbourhoods.
