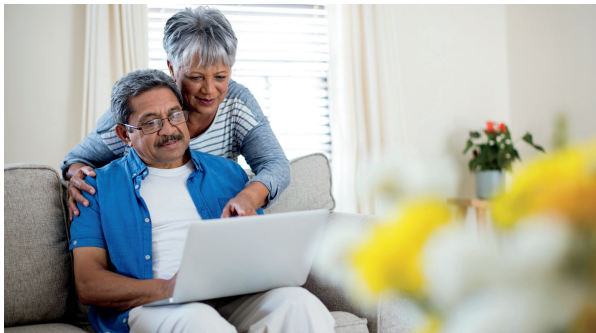

Safe Roads. Safe Neighbourhoods.

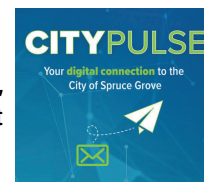
