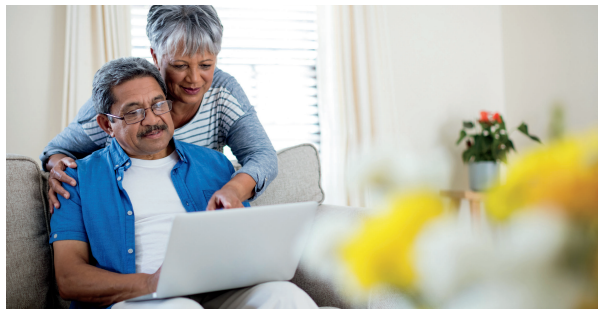
Dealing with grief through life's transitions
