

# Learn how to recognize Dutch Elm Disease and how to prevent it!

What is Dutch Elm Disease? It's a deadly disease that affects all species of elm trees and is caused by a fungus that is then spread by beetles.
Symptoms include: leaves suddenly wilting, leaves changing colour and shriveling but not falling, and discolouration once the bark is peeled back.
