# Learn how to spot and safely remove black knot

What is black knot? Black knot is a fungal disease that causes an infected plant to develop greenish brown to black swellings.

The disease affects a wide range of prunus species, including plums, cherries and apricots in Alberta. Until trees are pruned, the disease will continue to spread, reducing plant growth and deforming tree branches, potentially causing plants to die.
