Waste collection tips and cart storage reminders

As a responsible homeowner, remember to follow City guidelines when putting your black waste cart and green organics cart out for pick up to support safe and efficient neighbourhood waste collection.

Tips to keep waste pick up and storage moving smoothly:

- Place carts out by 7.a.m. on collection day and remove them by 11:59 p.m. the same day.
- Face carts towards the roadway and ensure lids are fully closed.
- Make sure carts have at least one metre of clearance on all sides.
- When carts are not out for collection, store them on your personal property.

Register to vote

Did you know you can check in advance to make sure you are registered to vote in the municipal election this fall? Find out if you are registered to vote by visiting voterlink.ab.ca and if you’re not, you can easily register online until August 15! This information will provide the City of Spruce Grove with a list of eligible voters, but don’t worry – if you arrive at a voting station and your name doesn’t appear on the permanent electors register, you will also have an opportunity to register to vote at that time.
