Waste collection tips and cart storage reminders

As a responsible homeowner, remember to follow City guidelines when putting your black waste cart and green organics cart out for pick up to support safe and efficient neighbourhood waste collection.

Tips to keep waste pick up and storage moving smoothly:

- Place carts out by 7 a.m. on collection day and remove them by 11:59 p.m. the same day.
- Face carts towards the roadway and ensure lids are fully closed.
- Make sure carts have at least one metre of clearance on all sides.
- When carts are not out for collection, store them on your personal property.

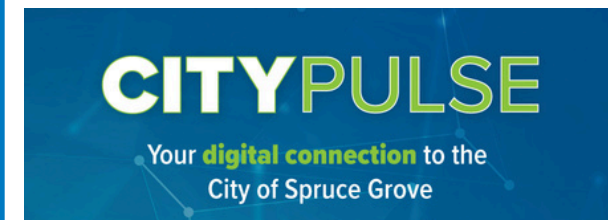
Advance voting dates for the 2025 municipal election
