Seasonal RV & ATV parking timelines

Whether you like to travel the Rockies in your RV or explore nature on your ATV, you'll need a place to park these vehicles throughout the year.

Starting November 15, tracked ATVs and snowmobiles can be parked on private residential property again, until April 15. After November 30, RVs, motorhomes, boats, campers and travel trailers must be stored in the rear yard of a private residential property, in a garage, or at an appropriate offsite location or facility – parking on private property can resume April 15.

When parking these vehicles, make sure they are kept clear from sidewalks and roadways to avoid blocking driver sightlines and to give pedestrians enough room to walk by. Learn more about RV and ATV parking at sprucegrove.org/RVParking.
