Seasonal RV & ATV parking timelines

Whether you like to travel the Rockies in your RV or explore nature on your ATV, you need a place to park these vehicles throughout the year.

Starting April 15, RVs, motorhomes, boats, campers and travel trailers can be parked on private residential property again, until November 30. After April 15, tracked ATVs and snowmobiles must be stored in the rear yard of a private residential property in a garage, or at an appropriate offsite location or facility – parking on private property can resume November 15.

When parking these vehicles, make sure they are kept clear from sidewalks and roadways to avoid blocking driver sightlines and to give pedestrians enough room to walk by. Learn more at sprucegrove.org/RVParking.
